Regular Meeting
September 08, 2021

The Regular meeting of the City council was called to order by Mayor Bryant Stiernagle, September 08th, 2021 at 6:00P.M. at the Easton Community Center.

In attendance Mayor Bryant Stiernagle, Council Members Gayle Heise, Jenny Stiernagle, Tony Stevermer & Jon Rath. & City Clerk Rose Doyle

Motion by Jenny Stiernagle second by Gayle Heise to accept minutes of August meeting. Motion carried.
Motion by Gayle Heise second by Jon Rath to accept financials. Motion carried.

Department Reports:

Police: Snow removal issues were explained to Tony Stevermer as he is the new police & fire rep on the council. There is also garbage issues at a residence on Elm St that need to be addressed.

Fire: Stevermer indicated he will address chief regarding the proper procedure of getting fire department bills paid.

Public Works: Travis Winter with Bolton & Menk gave a progress report on construction progress and stated all is on schedule and should be completed by the end of October. Elm St has all utilities in place and waiting for compaction and fill to be brought in so blacktopping can be completed. Cedar St. is progressing and within 3 weeks utilities should be in place. Boulevards and sodding will get done and stakes will be installed on Linder St for snow plowing purposes so not to upset sod that will be put down. 5th payment was presented for approval and motion by Jenny Stiernagle and second by Jon Rath to approve 5th payment application in the amount of \$513,040.81. Motion carried. The total paving of 3rd St from Ash to Cedar Street was discussed and council felt it is necessary to go ahead with the paving of the entire street with the city making the payment for the footage that was not included in the project. The amount will be presented to the council when it is figured out by engineer and construction company.

Streets & Buildings: Snow removal contract for upcoming snow season needs to be renewed. Gayle will get in touch with Swehla.

Tri City: No report.

Park & Rec: Bath rooms will be winterized in the near future.

Old Business: No report

New Business: Motion by Jon Rath second by Gayle Heise to approve building permit for Adam Wisch at A Little Something for a storage unit. Motion carried. Motion by Gayle Heise second by Jon Rath to approve building permit for Todd Machin for a fence, remodel and porch addition. Motion carried. Motion by Jon Rath second by Gayle Heise to set preliminary budget at 5%. Motion carried.

No further business to come before the council, motion by Jon Rath second by Gayle Heise to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
